

# Ontario Trust for Student Support (OTSS) and Ontario Student Opportunity Trust Fund (OSOTF II) Student Financial Aid Scholarships

*The Ontario Trust for Student Support Fund (OTSS) was established in 1996 by the Province of Ontario to provide financial support for Ontario college and university students in full-time postsecondary education. The funds raised by alumni, college students, Humber Student Federation, and various corporate partners are matched by the Government of Ontario.*

## Eligibility Criteria

To qualify for an OTSS student financial aid scholarship, applicants must:

- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or Protected Person\*
- have been a resident of Ontario for 12 consecutive months prior to starting school\*\*
- be enrolled in a full-time postsecondary program approved for funding by the Ministry of Training Colleges and Universities
- have demonstrated financial need
- have not received a student financial aid scholarship this academic year

**Note:** The applicant's academic progress is an important factor in determining eligibility for these student financial aid scholarships. His/her grades will be checked upon application.

## How to apply

- complete the OTSS Application and Budget Form
- attach a letter stating briefly how this financial aid scholarship will assist you in meeting your educational goals
- return the completed application form and attachments to the Financial Aid Office, Room D133, North Campus by the specified deadline.

**Note:** Applications that are incomplete or received past the deadline cannot be considered. Students may apply to more than one scholarship, however a separate letter and budget form must be submitted for each.

## The process

- student financial aid scholarship recipients will be selected based on the criteria outlined
- recipients will be notified by mail
- only those students selected to receive an OTSS student financial aid scholarship will be notified.

**Note:** All decisions by the committee are final!

## T4A

OTSS student financial aid scholarship recipients will receive a T4A for income tax purposes. All other Humber awards, bursaries, scholarships as well as other sources of financial assistance are also subject to income tax.
