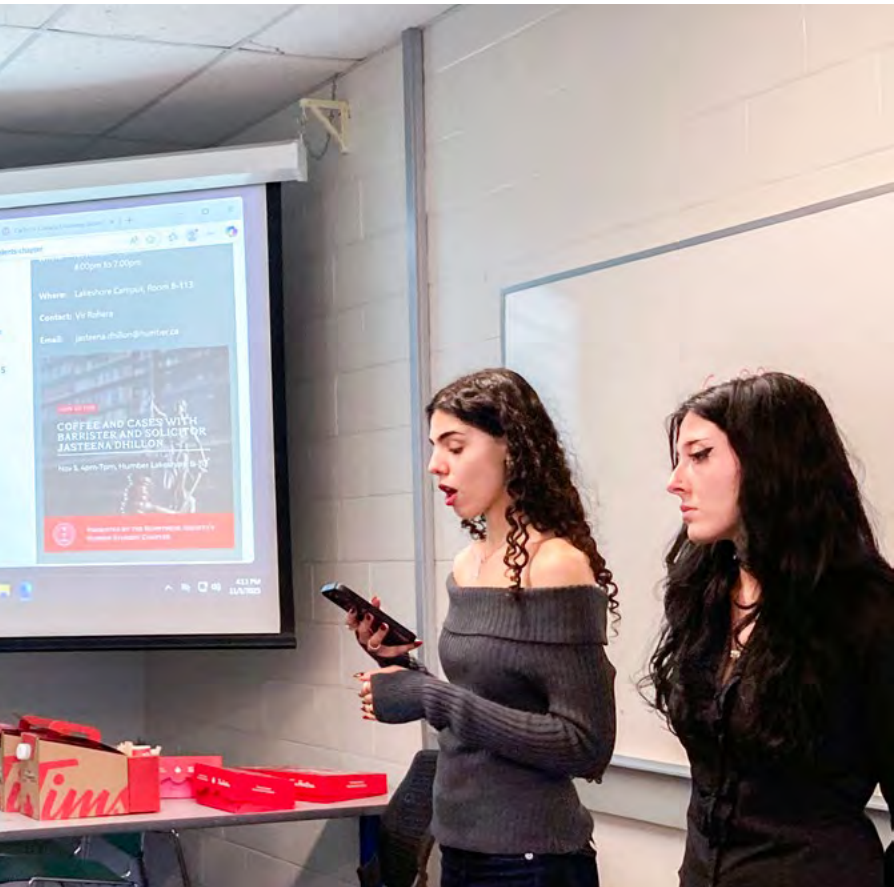


Paralegal Studies Degree Students Receive Expert Training in eDiscovery
